

CASE STUDY: Lingfield Primary School

REQUIREMENT: Wheelchair access to changing places toilet.

The ramp, landing, upstands, and handrails needed to be fully compliant with Approved Documents K and M of the Building Regulations.

A modular solution was chosen over concrete. Similarly to the changing place pod, a modular system can easily be removed and relocated. Concrete ramps do not offer these benefits.





END RESULT: A Rapid Ramp with a straight configuration was installed within a few hours.

This type of system is also known as a straight ramp, meaning it has no direction changes.

It includes a 1:15 compliant gradient and a platform that covers the width of the disabled door with turning room for wheelchairs.

FEATURES INCLUDED:

- Trombone Ends these are added to the ends of a Rapid Ramp to prevent clothes catching.
- Mesh Platform the self-draining mesh allows water to pass through rather than collect on the surface.
- Standard Continuous Handrail this handrail system ensures users always have support to hold onto.
- Black Powder Coated Finish rails are coated with thermosetting powder to provide a non-conductive, non-slip, scratch-resistant surface that is tougher than conventional paint.
